VOTING BY PROXY

If you are unable to vote on any of the dates above, you can appoint someone to act as your “proxy”. This allows you to appoint another elector to attend the voting place and cast your vote on your behalf. You can obtain an application form for proxy voting at the Township office or on the Township website: www.stjosephtownship.com. The deadline for making an application to vote by proxy is 4:00 p.m. on October 24, 2022.

IDENTIFICATION

Prior to receiving a ballot to vote, you will be required to provide proof of identity and residence.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

In order to vote in the 2022 municipal election, you must be:

1. 18 years of age or older and a Canadian Citizen
2. If you’re a resident, owner, or tenant (or spouse of an owner/tenant) of the Township of St. Joseph, you are eligible to vote for Council and a school Board Trustee
3. You are only allowed to vote within the school board jurisdiction once.
