Concert Series

Information Package

Purpose

The Just Passing Through (JPT) concert series was developed by the Richards Landing Events Committee in 2013. The purpose of the series is to provide a space for artists to play when traveling through the Algoma area. Audience numbers vary, typically from 20-60 people and are not guaranteed by the Committee. A minimum of 2, 45 minute sets are required for each performance. The committee looks for a variety of tempos during the performance, as well as audience engagement, as it is an intimate venue. The committee endeavours to provide a range of musical styles to the community through this series. When applying via email, please include links to music samples that represent recent music in both live and pre-recorded music if possible.

Sound Equipment

A Fender® Passport 500 system as well as two microphones and stands are available for use if artists require equipment.

Amp type: Class D

Woofers (per cab): 10"

Driver: (per cab): 1.2" horn-loaded

Inputs: 6 Mic/Line inputs, 2 stereo inputs

Output: 500W Class D power amp

Line Out: 1/8" mini stereo Out, subwoofer out

Channels: 8 (6 mic/line, 2 stereo)

6 mic lines with XLR and 1/4" inputs

2 stereo inputs with 1/4" and 1/8" (for MP3 player) inputs

1/4" subwoofer out with 120hz High-Pass Filter on Speaker Out

USB port that lets you record your performance with CD-quality (WAV) straight to a USB flash drive

CD-quality WAV and MP3 file playback

Controls: High EQ, Low EQ, Master Volume, System Tone, Level Control for each channel, Reverb Send for each channel, 20dB pad on input channels

Effects: Selectable and adjustable reverb

Artists Fees and Expenses

A split of ticket sales is used with this series. Ticket prices less than \$15 are a 90/10 split between the artist and committee respectively. Ticket prices above \$15 are subject to an 80/20 split between the artist and committee respectively.

The split is net of expenses incurred by the committee to host the show. These expenses vary from show to show based on artist need and other factors. Typical expenses include:

- SOCAN Fee paid by Township \$50
- Advertising (\$50.00 or more depending on artist/event need)
- Tickets and Poster Printing charges \$10

Bar and concession revenues and expenses are not subject to the artist/committee split.

The Committee does not guarantee any set profit for the JPT shows. Artist and Committee share risk for every show.

The Richards Landing Town hall, located at 1211 Richards Street, Richards Landing Ontario has a capacity of 110. The hall has a pleasant ambience and provides a great space for artists to display their talents in an intimate environment.
