Background

Early in 2023, Council approved the purchase of a new submersible pump for the lift station. The pump was purchased, but now requires installation. In addition to this, at their presentation in February 2023, the PUC recommended upgrading the electrical at the site to avoid further issues from occurring on the site.

The scope of work for the project is:

- Supply and install 2 new check valves.
- Mount new base to bottom of lift station.
- Install Flyght pump and base (already purchased)
- Supply and install guide rails with guide rail mount (provided)
- Fabricate and install new pipe connections.
- Run electrical from pump through explosion proof conduit into panel

PUC has secured quotes to complete this work from three contractors and recommends that Council award the work to Stobie Mechanical (all prices are net of tax):

1. McLeod Brothers - \$33,490.00

a. Has completed work at the site in the past.

Stobie Mechanical - \$14156.20
 S&T Group - \$12,144.00

a. budget estimate only, will be billed based on actual time and materials).

Stobie Mechanical was recommended by the PUC's environmental department which have worked with them in the past. Work can in January 2024 and all of the required certifications have been confirmed.

Financial Implications

The total amount of this expenditure will be included in the water and sewer budget for 2024.

Summary

Council may accept the quotation as presented, defer to budget discussions, or consider other options.
