Thessalon Community Days 2022

Saturday 30th: Parade down Main Street at 1pm (Parade contestants arrive at Thessalon Public school at 12 for judging at 12:30). Count all the smiley faces you see on the parade participants and submit your answer at Peace Park for your chance to win a prize!

After the parade make your way to Peace Park using the free Fairview bus to see the various vendors and bouncy castles (\$5 for an admission bracelet, bouncy castles only), beer gardens at the Arena from 2-4, and Lion's den dance Saturday night at 9pm. A bus is planned to shuttle people from Lakeside Park and Pine Crest Trailer Park to and from the arena during the dance.


Members of the Thessalon Lions Club will be selling raffle tickets throughout the weekend with the draw at Midnight on Saturday July 30.



EMAIL ON YOUR IPAD

FINDING THE MAIL APP

The Mail app is your primary email tool for both iPhones and iPads. The icon is often found on the dock on the lower part of any home screen. Tap the icon to launch the email app.




NOTIFICATIONS

A red **badge** will appear on the mail app icon that indicates how many unread emails are in your inbox. It allows you to see if you have new messages without opening the app.

SETTING UP YOUR EMAIL ACCOUNT

You can set up your existing email account to work with the iPad Email App. You can setup multiple email accounts if you have more than one, for example, an email for work and personal.

MANAGE YOUR INBOX The inbox is where you'll view and manage emails you receive. The Inbox and all



is displayed on the upper left. It is possible that you can setup multiple inboxes, for example, separate inboxes for work and personal in the Email app. Tap the inbox label to view other inboxes or to change to see inbox folders like Sent, Junk or Drafts.

2 Unread email

The blue dot next to an email displayed in the Inbox indicates that the email is unread. The dot will disappear after the email is displayed. It is possible to mark an email as read using step #6 below.

3 Move up and down the inbox with either drag or flick actions with your finger.

4 Search

You can search for emails by using the search bar at the top of the inbox. Swipe down on the email list to access the search bar.

Tap on the search bar and where you can choose categories of emails (Unread, Flagged, VIP or Attachments) or you can type a search term, for example "Invoice" against either the current mailbox or All Mailboxes if you have multiple accounts.

Bulk Edit or Manage
Tap Edit at the top of the Inbox list.

6 Manage with a Swipe

If you swipe left on a single email, you are given Actions that can be performed on that email like: Reply, Reply All, Forward


Mark – Flag, Mark as Read, Move to Junk


Notify Me – a notification if there is a reply to the email.


Move Message – move to a different mailbox or folder.

Hamburger Beef Stroganoff

INGREDIENTS

1lb lean ground beef
1 small onion
1 clove of garlic minced
2 cans sliced mushrooms, drained
3 tbsp flour
2 cups beef broth
2 tsp Worcestershire sauce
salt & pepper to taste
¾ cup sour cream



DIRECTIONS

Brown the hamburger, onion and garlic (trying not to break it up too much), in a heavy bottom pot, until no pink remains. Drain off any fat.

In a measuring cup, measure out broth, Worcestershire sauce and salt and pepper.

Add mushrooms to meat and cook a few more minutes. Stir in the flour well.

Slowly add broth mixture to meat, stirring while adding.

Reduce heat to simmer for 10 minutes.


Remove from heat and stir in the sour cream well.


Serve over cooked egg noodles.
